The term caring is broad and includes the following aspects:

- Individual: taking care of oneself, one's personal health and well-being.
- Relational: rejection of hierarchical, dominating and privileged relationships between people and rejection of violence.
- Family and social networks: care work necessary to ensure the daily physical, social and emotional well-being of family members and other close relatives; care for people in need (children, elderly, sick, people with disabilities), household maintenance (cleaning, shopping, cooking).

The term caring is broad and includes the following aspects:

- Occupational: occupations in education, health and social care (early carers and educators, primary school teachers, nurses, carers, social workers).
- Social solidarity: concern for the community and society in general (e.g. voluntary work, participation in social movements, empathy and solidarity towards excluded and marginalised social groups).
- Ecological: care for nature and the planet.
